Modi led the awakening of the movement from his state, Gujarat. As an RSS pracharak he awakened the national consciousness and during this time, as a preacher, he made the whole of India aware of the Ram Temple.

CONTRIBUTION AS A BJP LEADER

Narendra Modi joined the BJP in 1980. After which in 1989, the party appointed him the General Secretary of Gujarat unit. In 1990, he was made a member of the National Election Committee. By the end of the 1990s, he was made the National General Secretary of the BJP and during this period, he also worked for the cause of Ram Mandir with the party. On 12 September 1990, Lal Krishna Advani's Rath Yatra was carried out from Somnath in Gujarat to Ayodhya whose organiser was Narendra Modi. ₹10,000 crore needed every 15 years: EC to Central Govt

The Election Commission has estimated that an amount of Rs 10,000 crore would be required every 15 years to procure new Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) if simultaneous elections are conducted for the Lok Sabha and assemblies. In a communication sent to law ministry, poll panel highlighted that the shelf life of EVMs is 15 years and one set of machines

could be used for 3 cy-



cles of elections in their lifespan if simultaneous polls were held. For upcoming LS polls, it is estimated that a total of 11.80 lakh polling stations would be required.



Take Time to Prepare and Train

He arranged adequate resources for the war, trained his Army well and built adequate infrastructure, to ensure success. Taking lessons from Ramayan, Bangladesh War (1971) was an ideal campaign by Indian Armed Forces, which was well planned and executed to perfection. resources in a pre-emptive strike by putting the Lanka to flames was 'aim plus', which was well achieved.

Use Local Resources Shree Ram made excellent use of local resourc-

es. He created an army of local tribals (vanaras). The local tribals were well aware of ground, routes and art of jungle warfare. They could survive off the land and did not require a long logistics tail. He also created war infrastructure like 'Ram Setu' – a land bridge up-to Lanka using locally available floating coral reefs. Usage of the available local resources efficiently, is important military lesson from Ramayan.




