Modi's Game-Changer 'Make in India' move!

PM Modi and Spanish Prez Sanchez inaugurate India's first ever TATA Aircraft complex

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Spanish President Pedro Sanchez on Monday jointly inaugurated an aircraft manufacturing facility in Gujarat's Vadodara, which will collaborate with Spain's Airbus to develop fighter aircraft. The Tata aircraft complex, slated to manufacture 40 C-295 aircraft beginning in 2026, will be producing India's first privately built military aircraft.

Addressing the event, Modi said that the aircraft manufacturing facility will enhance defence capabilities and strengthen relations between India & Spain. He said, "From today, we are giving a new direction to India and Spain's partnership. We are inaugurating production factory of C-295 aircraft." Sanchez said, in addition to contributing to modernising India's defence capabilities, facility will also drive technological devpt. **P12**

Centre to begin census from 2025, delimitation to follow

The government is expected to begin the next census, an official survey of the country's population, in 2025 after a four-year-long delay. The process will commence in 2025 and is expected to continue until 2026. Following Census, delimitation of LS seats will commence, and this exercise is likely to be completed by 2028, sources said.

3 terrorists killed after attack on Army vehicle in J&K's Akhnoor, gunfight on

At least 3 terrorists were killed in a gunfight after they opened fire on an Army vehicle in Jammu and Kashmir's Akhnoor sector on Monday, sources said. Security forces also seized arms and ammunition from the area, and the encounter was ongoing.

At around 7 am in the Batal area, 3 terrorists opened multiple rounds of fire at the Army vehicle. The security forces promptly cordoned off the area and launched a manhunt, according to sources.

The incident took place as security forces in Jammu and Kashmir had implemented elaborate security measures in the Jammu region in preparation for the Diwali festival season. BMP-2 infantry combat vehicles of the Indian Army have been deployed to the encounter site, where the operation is currently ongoing, officials said.

CM SHARMA, RATHORE PRESIDE BJP'S WORKSHOP

Strengthen organisational efforts: CM to party workers

The BJP held an organizational workshop on Monday at its state headquarters, chaired by President Madan Rathore and attended by Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma.

The workshop featured 2 sessions with key guests, including National Vice President Rekha Verma and State poll in-charge Narayan Panchariya. CM Sharma urged district heads and party workers to strength-

He further expressed the confidence that winning all seven seats in the by-elections would further strengthen the government and boost the morale of the workers.

RTO transfers stuck despite Dy CM's nod

The posting process for new RTOs in Kota and Bikaner is currently on hold, despite Dy CM Dr PC Bairwa's recommendations for appointments in these locations. The RTO position in Kota has been vacant since the retirement of the previous RTO, while the current RTO in Bikaner, Rajesh Sharma, has been promoted to Joint Commissioner. However, no action has been taken so far, as the file for appointment of new RTOs has not yet reached the ARD or Dy CM. Dr Bairwa suspended transport inspectors Prabhat Ranjan, Jitendra Meena, and Dheer Singh in Dholpur for illegally collecting fees from trucks, following orders from Transport Headquarters.

Additionally, the DTO of Churu has been designated as Awaiting Posting Order (APO). Following Deputy CM Prem Chand Bairwa's directions, DTO Om Singh was made APO.

SI training to end soon, Govt must decide on exam

Jaipur: The government must act swiftly on canceling the Sub-Inspector (SI) recruitment exam, as selected candidates are in the final stages of training at the Rajasthan Police Academy, concluding next month.

The recruitment exam is scheduled for December, followed by the passing-out parade. Any delay may allow newly selected SIs to take charge at police stations, but major decisions are expected post by-elections.

NGT forms committee for Chandlai Lake pollution

The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has sought a factual report from the state government regarding the rising pollution and encroachment around Chandlai Lake, located a short distance from the capital. Hearing a petition, the Tribunal formed a committee of officials.

Following directives from the Central Zone Bench of the Tribunal in Bhopal, officers from the environment department, water resources department, revenue department, Pollution Control Board, Rajasthan Wetland Authority and central and state pollution control boards assessed the situation. They examined encroachments in the area and identified dyeing and printing units that are illegally discharging industrial waste into the lake's flow area. The NGT is scheduled to hold the next hearing on this matter on Nov 8, by which time the govt departments have to submit a factual report.

The case, Devi Lal Khatri v. Rajasthan State and others, was heard by the NGT on July 27. The

petition claims that the catchment area of Chandlai Lake is being encroached upon, industrial waste is being dumped directly into the lake without treatment and the population of migratory birds visiting the lake is rapidly declining due to

increasing pollution and encroachment. The Rajasthan Lake Conservation and Development Authority Act is applicable in state, allowing the authority to remove any structures within lake's protected and flow areas.

A notification for the conservation of Chandlai was issued by State Wetland Authority on Aug 31, 2023. In a meeting on Sept 8, 2023, it was decided that encroachments would be regularly removed; however, pollution and encroachment continue to persist.

'Awara' and 'Besahara' words not be used for cows, says Kumawat

In Jaipur, Animal Husbandry and Dairy Minister Joraram Kumawat held a meeting with officials from Gopalan Dept to discuss new directives regarding cattle welfare. Following the meeting, he addressed the media, announcing that terms like "Awara" (stray) and "Besahara" (abandoned) will no longer be used to describe cattle. Instead, "Nirashrit" (destitute) will be adopted in government records.

Kumawat emphasized the cultural significance of cows, stating, "Cows are our mothers, providing us with milk and other products." He condemned the societal tendency to neglect cattle and highlighted the responsibility to protect them. Furthermore, he noted that the department is studying Maharashtra's recent decision to elevate cows to status of 'Rajmata', and will present findings to the Chief Minister Bhajana Lal Sharma for the further consideration.

Bharatpur medical college takes action in ragging case; 10 students face suspension

In the case of ragging at Shri Jagannath Paharia Medical College in Bharatpur, the college administration has suspended 10 senior students including 7 female students and 3 male students for seven days. Their punishment will begin after the Diwali holidays, during which time they will be barred from using the library, sports facilities, gym, and similar areas for one month.

The incident occurred on October 21. Thirteen first-year MBBS female students were subjected to ragging by 10 senior students, who blocked them in the common room, forced them to reveal their hobbies, and compelled them to sing. Disturbed by the ragging,

the students reported the matter to the college principal. Following this, the anti-ragging committee conducted an investigation. As soon as Principal Dr Tarun Lal became aware of the issue, he immediately activated the anti-ragging committee. All the affected students were called to the principal's office. Although the students initially declined any form of action, the principal took the matter seriously.

BANGLADESHI MIGRANT HELD WITH FAKE AADHAAR

➔ Jaipur: In a campaign against illegal migrants, a 45-year-old man suspected to be a Bangladeshi residing here has been arrested. Police team raided the Bhankrota police station area of Jaipur and arrested him. They also arrested the accused who made fake Aadhaar of Bangladeshis. The arrested man was shown as an 18-year-old in Aadhaar. Police had earlier held 12 Bangladeshis.

DEOGARH TENSE AFTER 2 MINORS ASSAULTED

➔ Rajasmand: Deogarh in the district was tense on Monday after two minor boys were beaten up on Sunday in the Khatik locality over a minor dispute. Meanwhile, protesters reached the police station for police not acting against people of a particular community who assaulted the minors. People from either communities gathered on the spot where the incident happened.

MAJOR DRUG BUST: POLICE SEIZE 680 KG POPPY HUSK BEING TRAFFICKED IN AN AMBULANCE

➔ Barmer: In a significant crackdown on drug trafficking, the Baitu police, under the guidance of SP Kundan Kanwariya, seized an ambulance filled with approximately 680 KGs of illegal poppy husk. The operation led to the arrest of the trafficker, Bhoma Ram, son of Rukaram, a resident of Sanawada, Barmer. The action was executed under the supervision of Baitu DSP Shiv Narayan Chaudhary and SHO BL Vishnoi, along with their team. The police are currently interrogating the suspect regarding the poppy husk.

SECURITY AGENCIES DETAIN SUSPICIOUS MAN NEAR INDO-PAK BORDER WITH MOBILE & SIMS

➔ Jaisalmer: In a significant security operation near the India-Pakistan border near Pokaran, security agencies successfully apprehended a suspicious individual disguised as a madman. During the probe, authorities discovered a mobile phone, SIMs, and a diary containing a list of mobile numbers on suspect. Sources indicate that security agencies have heightened their vigilance in anticipation of Diwali.

The youth and players of Rajasthan will no longer need to run around for support, as three new portals have been launched by the Youth Affairs and Sports Department to provide a single-window facility.

The three portals, launched by Sports Minister Singh Rathore, include a registration portal for the "Yuva Mahotsav" youth festival at the block, district, division, and state levels, a registration portal for the "Rajasthan Youth Icon Award," and a "Digital Repository" for players' sports certificates. Launched on Monday, these portals aim to centralize essential information related to youth

and sports in one integrated platform.

Speaking at the launch, Col. Rathore highlighted that the repository portal will allow athletes to safely store their sports certificates digitally, relieving them from the worry of keeping physical certificates secure.

The Sports Minister added that the portals were developed as part of various budget initiatives under the Youth Affairs and Sports Department. A "State Youth Festival" is proposed to be held on January 12, inspired by the National Youth Festival. The Yuva Mahotsav Portal

will facilitate registrations for the Youth Festival, open to young participants aged 15-29 across different competition levels, to celebrate and promote talent, culture, and creativity among the youth.

Col. Rathore emphasized that the Yuva Mahotsav Portal provides a unique platform to showcase youth talent and encourage cultural and creative skills while raising awareness of social issues and motivating active participation. He added that, similar to the National Youth Award, Rajasthan will now recognise young achievers aged 15-29 with Yuva Prema and Yuva Icon Awards via registration portal. Gurugram is the epicentre of Haryana's progress

Haryana has recently emerged from the election cycle and the ruling political party there has once again made a comeback. Haryana is often talked about on the Indian canvas because of those Haryanvis who win medals in prestigious sports events at the global level like the Olympics and bring glory to the country. In the past couple of months, as discussions on economic development took place during the election season in Haryana, it was frequently noted in analyses that this state, which came into existence on November 1, 1966, alongside Punjab, has significantly outpaced Punjab in economic growth in recent years. Moreover, in terms of per capita income, Haryana is now ranked among the leading states in India. Statistics also show that Haryana's per capita income is higher than the national average. However, a contradiction often surfaces in these discussions: Haryana's unemployment rate is higher than the national average. Why is this so? According to a recent report, women's participation in the workforce in Haryana is the lowest among all Indian states. This can largely be attributed to the rural setup of the state. As per the 2023-24 data, while the national workforce participation rate is around 60%, in Haryana, it stands at only 49.5%. This means that a smaller portion of the workforce in Haryana is employed. Yet, Haryana's annual unemployment rate is 3.4%, compared to the national average of 3.2%.

This raises questions and creates confusion about how high per capita income and high unemployment can coexist. When discuss-

ing Haryana's economic development, it would be incomplete without mentioning the city of Gurugram. Formerly known as Gurgaon, Gurugram currently pays income taxes amounting to 50,000 crores annually. Over the past two decades, this figure has seen a 20% increase each year. This clearly shows Gurugram's significant contribution to the Indian economy, contributing approximately 3% to 5% to the nation's GDP. Gurugram has the highest per capita income in India.

The industrial growth of this city began in 1980 when the then Congress government established the Maruti industrial plant. Notably, Maruti is a joint venture between the Government of India and the Japanese company Suzuki, and it has maintained a reputation as the most trusted car brand for Indians for four decades. Following this, Gurugram benefited greatly from its proximity to Delhi, whether it be access to an international airport or other amenities. Then, with the economic reforms of 1991, India shifted its focus to-

wards the service sector, and the service sector's contribution to the GDP exceeded 50%. Gurugram attracted the most attention from the service sector and, in the last two decades, has grown into a large metropolitan city, on par with the capitals of some of India's most developed states (Mumbai, Bengaluru, Ahmedabad, Hyderabad).

Today, when it comes to economic progress, Gurugram has come to symbolize Haryana. However, this has led to severe consequences, with high unemployment and significant economic disparity in other parts of Haryana. The unemployed in Haryana are increasingly turning towards Gurugram as they have no other option. A report by CMIE also confirms this skewed focus on economic development in Haryana. According to the report, over 61% of Haryana's industrial units are concentrated in Gurugram alone. These units receive 97% of the state's total capital expenditure, while the remaining 40% of industrial units in other cities get only 3% of the allocation.

VATICAN DENIES WOMEN BIGGER ROLE IN CHURCH



The Vatican's recent refusal to grant women the right to serve as clergy has brought forth a longstanding issue within the Catholic Church: gender inequity in roles of religious authority. While Pope Francis has taken bold steps in other areas—embracing modern social issues, advocating for climate action, and promoting economic justice—his stance on women in the priesthood remains conservative, even rigid. At a recent Synod proponents of a bigger role for women in the Church felt the Pope was unwilling to help their cause.

This contradiction between progressive policy and traditional gender roles reflects an enduring unwillingness to re-evaluate doctrines that no longer resonate with many Catholics.

Women have contributed immensely to the Church's spiritual and community life for centuries, yet they remain systematically excluded from its highest offices. By denying women the opportunity to serve as clergy, the Church limits the diversity of voices that could enrich its teachings and deepen its relevance for a global congregation. Recent surveys show that many Catholics support gender equality within church leadership, signalling that a shift in this direction would align with the evolving views of faithfuls.

In a time when religious institutions are losing influence, embracing inclusive practices could revitalise the Church and address its declining membership, especially among younger, progressive generations. True reform requires Pope Francis and the Vatican to confront gender inequality openly and acknowledge the value that female clergy could bring to the Church. For a faith rooted in compassion and justice, denying women's rightful place in religious leadership feels not only outdated but also misaligned with its core teachings.

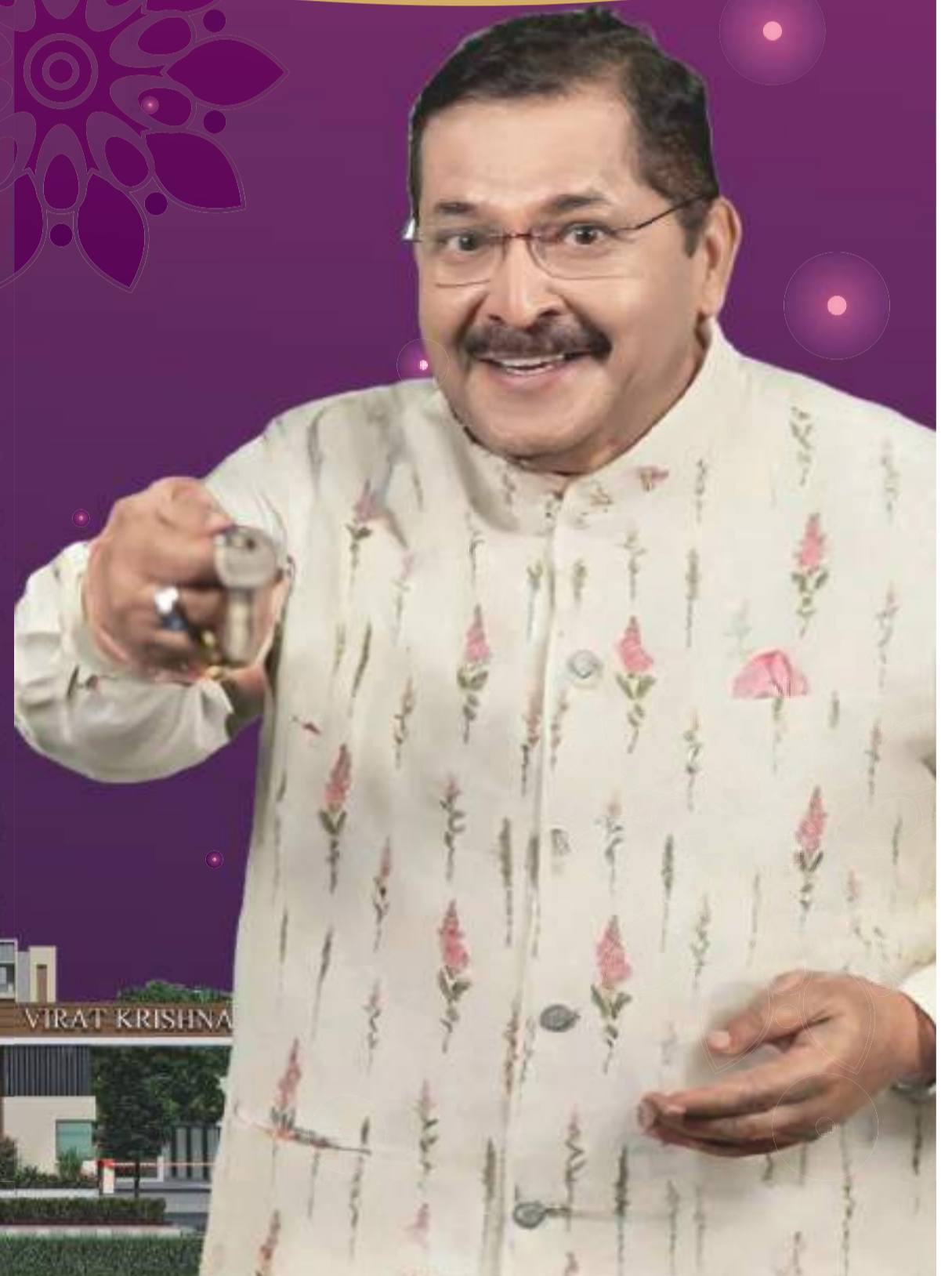

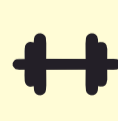

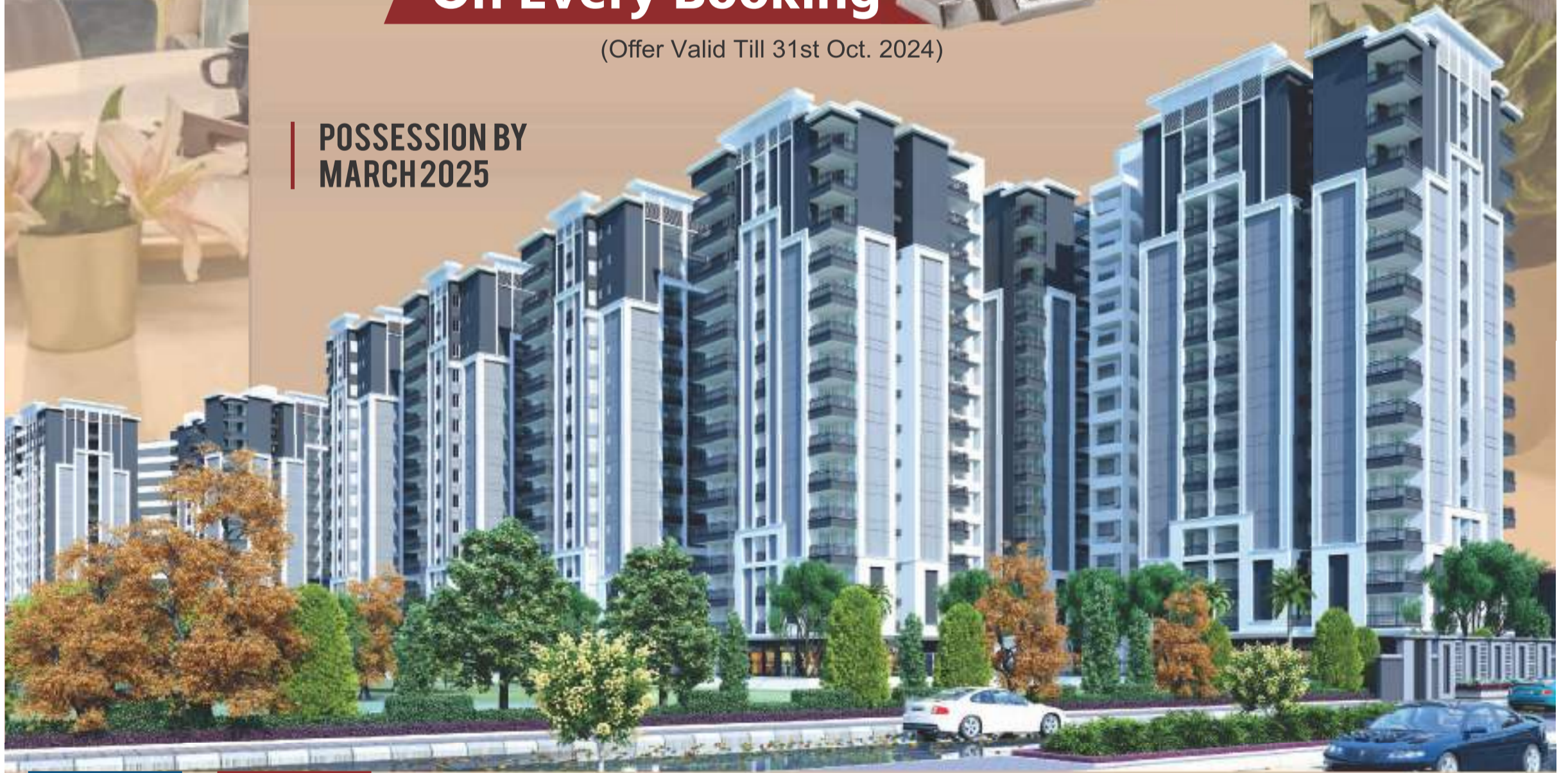

The precious metal of 99.9 per cent and 99.5 per cent purity had revisited its all-time of Rs 81,500 and Rs 81,100 per 10 grams, respectively, on Saturday.

However, silver remained flat at Rs 99,500 per kg.

Meanwhile, gold of 99.5 per cent purity declined Rs 400 to Rs 80,700 per 10 grams on Monday.

Ease in demand by jewellers and stockists in the local markets amid sluggish trend in the global markets led to a decline in gold prices, traders said.

"Hezbollah's activities force the (Israeli army) to act against it forcefully," military spokesman Avichay Adraee said in a post on X, urging residents to "head north".

An accompanying map showed large swathes of the city marked in red, including an area abutting a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Under the guidance of Additional Chief Secretary (Energy) Alok and Principal Secretary (RRECL) Alok Gupta, 388 MW rooftop solar projects have been finalized in line with the recent budget announcement. These projects will be installed across 17 districts using the Hybrid Annuity Model (HAM), which minimises financial strain on the govt. A tender process has been initiated for a total capacity of 1,173 MW.

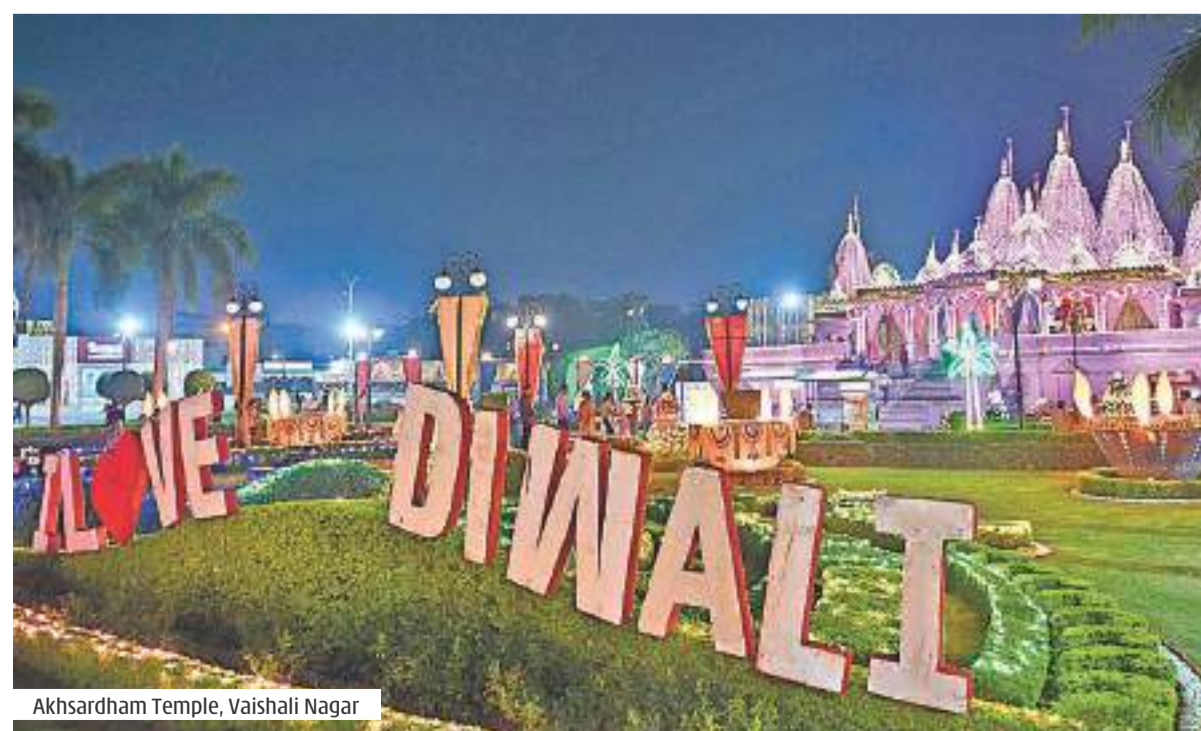

It's raining stars in Charlotte. In the last four days, first basketball match of home team Charlotte Hornets took place,

former president Barack Obama campaigned for Kamala Harris and there was a Usher concert.

"The city is alive and buzzing, it can't get any better. Good for business and a dash of politics always make things exciting," says a 60 year old Gary Mac who is standing in a long queue to get through the seasons first NBA game. Mac is tight lipped about his ballot that he had cast on the opening day of early voting but says its going to be a close battle in North Carolina is considered swing for this

election. In the last six presidential elections since 2000 barring the exception of 2008 when Democrat Barack Obama won here, this Tar Heel State has always voted Republican irrespective of the outcome of presidential race going their way or not.

The 15 electoral college votes the state carries become significant for both Harris and Trump. In the last two elections the margin of victory for Trump has reduced from 3.6% in 2016 against Hillary Clinton to 1.3% against Biden.



With a sizeable population of African Americans and Hispanic voters, the state's democratic base has energised, and Harris campaign is picking up. The two major cities Capital Raleigh and Charlotte are going to be crucial for Harris's fortune, Democrats

gain from urban centres and if she can add to her tally here, she is in the game feel locals.

"Urban centres are her only chance, the sizeable population of African Americans, Hispanics and if she is able to add women voters to this tally she has a realistic chance. Else, it the state will yield results like it has over the years," says Kevin Marshall a resident of Charlotte. idential, and he just didn't do that," says Kevin asserting why he shifted loyalties this time.

The most pressing issue in North Carolina is abortion rights, way over inflation and crime that are close second and third. "If the white women vote on this issue for Democrats, then it is a big issue for Trump. I gather last election he got over 50% votes from white women, if they shift from him to Kamala only on abortion rights. The balance will tilt Democrats," says Chauneer Ashton a schoolteacher.

That apart hurricane Helena, that devastated the state too will have its implications in outcome. There has been massive misinformation drive, relief work by Biden administration has been questioned adding to Harris campaign's worries but it also has caused damaged in rural areas that have been Republican strong hold. For Harris to win she needs to add votes in urban areas and persuade women to vote for her, whereas for Trump key is to ensure that he holds on to rural voters & add some base in Urban areas.

NaMo: Architect of a Changing World Order!

INDIA-CHINA BORDER ROW AGREEMENT IS A BIG WIN FOR MODI'S DIPLOMACY: Dr CHANDRA

In the latest episode of the JC Show, **Dr Jagdeesh Chandra** emphasises the transformative impact of Narendra Modi's leadership on India's global stature, describing him as the architect of a new world order. He highlights the rising concerns in the West regarding India's strengthening alliances with Russia and China, and how this could shift the global balance of power. Additionally, Dr Chandra stresses that UP CM Yogi Adityanath's recent confidence boost after meeting Mohan Bhagwat signals a unified party front, while Amit Shah's strategic electoral approach continues to shape the BJP's fortunes. As the party prepares for upcoming elections, the selection of a new president remains a focal point of speculation. Excerpts...

● **The show's headline is "NaMo: Architect of a Changing World Order!" What does this mean?**

Dr Jagdeesh Chandra: Did you see the photograph of Narendra Modi, Xi, and Putin? This image is truly shocking and incendiary. It points towards a new world, a new politics, and a new diplomacy. It's being said that India has attained a strategic position. In this new world order, Narendra Modi is a breath of fresh air. Under his leadership, we feel like a proud nation... a proud country.

● **Why is West troubled by this new world order?** Of course, the West is troubled because American dominance will no longer prevail over nations, and its control and influence will decrease.

The American foreign policy has two targets: to weaken Russia and to stop China's expansionism. India is a balancing factor. When India stands strong, it forms a coalition. Hence, it's natural for the U.S. to be concerned. From a business perspective, both countries have a GDP of \$15 trillion, while America's is \$27 trillion, which isn't too different. The U.S.'s concern is quite understandable. There's a fear that these three nations could form a position that makes America strategically weak. The U.S. worries that it might become weaker in international diplomacy. This concern is shared by the Western world, including France, Germany, and Canada. They too have raised eyebrows over this

issue, and their concern is natural.

● **Do you agree with the assessment that the three heroes of the BRICS summit are India's Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Russia's President Putin, and China's President Xi Jinping?**

If we look closely, the true centre of attraction was Narendra Modi. Everyone wanted to meet him. The number of people wanting to meet Xi was quite low, and there was no particular attraction to meeting Putin. Modi's personality has created a frame where everyone wants to meet him. He was one of the most popular and strategic faces in Russia. One could say that the real hero was Narendra Modi, the strategic hero was Narendra Modi.

● **Why is Narendra Modi so elated and excited after returning from Russia?**

Well, India's brand has strengthened, and India's stature has increased in the world. After returning from Russia, it is natural for Narendra Modi to be pleased. He has returned with accomplishments and dignity. He has strengthened India's brand, so feeling happy and elated is completely natural.

● **During the meeting, Putin pointed to Modi and said that their relationship is such that no translator is needed. What did Putin mean by this? Also, former British Prime Minister Cameron said Modi has a clear vision for India's**

future; can you elaborate on that?

This shows Putin's trust and confidence in Modi as a friend and leader. It indicates a level of comfort in their relationship. When Modi heard this, he laughed heartily. Often, those who visit, like the foreign minister who went with him, are impressed by the quality of their relationship and communication. As for the former British Prime Minister's comment, he is right. This means we have another Modi supporter in Britain. It can be said that there are now fans of Modi in Britain as well. It's true that today he has a vision for 2047, along with a five-year and 125-day plan in front of him. All these graphs are presented to him, and there is clarity in his vision and planning. He rightly said that Modi has a long-term vision for India and long-term planning for the country.

● **How did the sudden agreement between India and China come about before PM Modi's visit to Russia? What is the inside story? What roles did Jaishankar, Doval, and Mistry play in this?** There is a common impression that this happened suddenly. We also thought that, but it wasn't sudden; it was four years of groundwork. This was the result of Narendra Modi's vision and leadership. Overall, there have been 21 meetings at the army commanders' level and 17 at the diplomatic level. A lot of groundwork went into this. Look

at Jaishankar—he mentioned in Geneva that the issue of troop withdrawal in Eastern Ladakh was 75% resolved. He gave an indication that day. Doval is all-in-one; he met Putin in Russia, and we cannot deny Putin's role. The Foreign Secretary is very clear-minded, and he also said that day, "Let's see, let's create trust." Their roles were not sudden; rather the current agreement is the result of four and a half years of hard work.

● **In this atmosphere of goodwill between India and China, will China now support India's proposal for permanent membership in the UN Security Council?**

It is possible. I have heard that China has objections to Japan. Perhaps the President of France has sent a proposal stating that India, Japan, and Brazil should be granted permanent membership. China feels that if a major

issue arises, Japan will side with the U.S. For India, it's clear, but not for Japan. I am hopeful that in the coming time, India may get it. Previously, China had used its veto to block it, but perhaps this time China will not veto.

● **Regarding the upcoming assembly elections in India, after Haryana, will the BJP also win in Ranchi and Mumbai?**

After the recent victory in Haryana, the BJP's enthusiasm is soaring, bolstered by Amit Shah's effective strategy. This win has significantly boosted morale and altered perceptions within the party, particularly in Ranchi and Mumbai. In Ranchi, the BJP currently holds a slight edge at 51% compared to the opposition's 49%, with potential to shift to a stronger 60-40 margin. In Maharashtra, however, the competition is more intense, with projections suggesting a close race at 51-49 or even 50-50. Amit Shah previously asserted that the BJP would secure a two-thirds majority, and this outlook remains valid. The opposition in Maharashtra is unified, but if public sentiment shifts favorably, a 55-45 outcome could emerge. Interestingly, the Congress appears to be faltering, having compromised on numerous issues, which may lead to internal conflicts among leaders like Uddhav Thackeray, Sharad Pawar, and Rahul Gandhi. Meanwhile, the BJP has resolved its own internal disputes, positioning itself well for the up-

coming elections. The dynamics will be clearer in the days ahead.

● **How does Amit Shah manage to win every election like a game of chess with his mindset?**

He changes the game because he treats every election like a war. This sometimes leads to ideological differences with the RSS. The RSS believes that people like Ajit Pawar, who do not have a background in the RSS and BJP, need 8-10 months of training before joining. They should learn the values and understand the conditions here before entering party. This leads to psychological and ideological differences in functioning styles between Shah and the RSS. Amit Shah insists that we must fight and win like a war. Every election he has won has been with this approach. In the Maharashtra elections, one person is working 24 hours—that person is Shah. Earlier, I used to wonder about when Modi sleeps; now, I find myself wondering about when Shah sleeps. He knows how to win elections like a game of chess. We will see what happens in Maharashtra and Jharkhand. Another interesting aspect of Shah is that I mentioned he fights like chess; while doing so, he created a new party in the country, the Party of Independents. Wherever he sees that his candidate is not there or the space is vacant, as he did in Kashmir, he has set up an independent party. However, given the mind-

set in Valley, that experiment was not very successful. In Haryana, it was successful, so he established separate departments to determine where and how to field independent candidates. He deserves credit as a warrior for winning this battle, having formed new party outside of Congress and the BJP called the Party of Independents.

● **What is the latest update regarding the appointment of the new BJP president?**

The latest is that the RSS's bargaining power has diminished. Previously, names like Sanjay Joshi, Vasundhara Raje, and Shivraj Singh Chouhan were mentioned. Haryana has changed the game, and I've heard that the RSS also played a role there.
