

Ganpati visarjan turns fatal in Pratapgarh and Pali, 6 drown

In a tragic accident in Chhoti Sadri of Pratapgarh three children drowned in water during Ganpati immersion. Two boys Himanshu Yadav and Shubham Yadav died on the spot, while one. Kirtesh Yadav was critically injured. Workers from a nearby railway project rescued Kritesh. Former Shrichand Kriplani visited the scene, which occurred near the Barwada Gurjar village river.

Meanwhile in another incident, during Ganesh immersion in Pali 3 young men drowned in a pond. After intense efforts, with the help of divers the bodies were recovered. ASP Vipin Kumar and Tehsildar Dilip Singh were present at the scene.

The deceased are said to be residents of Sojat. The incident occurred in the Khokhara village of the Sojat City Police Station jurisdiction. The bodies of the deceased have been moved to the mortuary of Government Hospital in Sojat.

3 held for disrespecting national flag

Three persons were arrested for allegedly insuiting the national flag by tampering it with Islamic symbols during a Barawafat procession, officials said on Tuesday.

Two minors involved in the incident were also identified and will be detained, they said.

Police said a video surfaced on social media purportedly showing a person waving the national flag that had a crescent and star printed on either side of the Ashoka Chakra.

The accused, Chhinder Kaur and son Jagga Singh, killed Singh by hitting on his head with a stick. The accused have confessed to the murder.

Sources said that for a period of three months, around 60 liquor stores remained untendered, resulting in an estimated revenue loss of approximately Rs 30 crore. Currently, there is a shortage of bidders for 15 liquor shops in the

Medical professionals, especially in such a sensitive case, required immediate assurances of safety and justice. Instead, the delay in meeting their demands prolonged the unrest. Given the circumstances, a quicker response could have helped defuse the tension early on.






Govt talking to Meitei and Kuki groups for lasting peace: Shah

Explosions in Lebanon and Syria kill at least 8

Hundreds of handheld pagers exploded near simultaneously Lebanon and in parts of Syria on Tuesday, killing at least eight people, including members of the militant group Hezbollah and a girl, and wounding the Iranian ambassador, the government officials said on Tuesday.

Officials pointed the finger at Israel in what appeared to be a sophisticated, remote attack that wounded more than 2,700 people at a time of rising tensions across the Lebanon border. The Israeli military declined to comment.

A Hezbollah official who spoke on condition of anonymity told media that the new brand of handheld pagers used by the group first heated up, then exploded, killing at least two of its members and wounding others.
